re your letter of 8/8/91 regarding our application to organise The WRDA Welsh Saloon and Sports Car Championship 1992.

The WRDA Welsh Saloon and Sports Car Championship is a grass roots championship and its purpose is to assist in the revival of racing in Wales after a period of 10 years in which no racing occurred in the Principality. To that end we are proud to report that, this year we have attracted 4 new competitors who have taken their first steps in The WRDA Welsh Saloon and Sports Car Championship, but who otherwise would have been discouraged from competing by reasons of expense and travel. From these beginnings they may wish to progress but The WRDA Welsh Saloon and Sports Car Championship has provided them with an entry point to the sport.

The WRDA Welsh Saloon and Sports Car Championship has assisted in the promotion of motor racing in Wales by providing local interest stories to the Welsh media.

If The WRDA Welsh Saloon and Sports Car Championship is not allowed in 1992, there will be no Welsh Championships and this surely cannot benefit grass roots motorsport.

2. Eligible Cars. Saloon Cars and Sports cars as follows.

2.1 Class A. Cars complying to RAC Modified Saloon car, or Group A Touring Car Regulations, over 2 litres capacity.

2.2 Class B. Cars complying to RAC Modified Saloon car, or Group A Touring Car Regulations, up to 2 litres capacity.

2.3. Class C for Cars complying with RAC Production Saloon Car regulations, or any car for which a Production Car Specification has been issued. Except in respect of regulation 8.6 Brakes. In this respect for reasons of safety if the original production car was not fitted ventilated front brakes, ventilated discs of the same material and swept area original equipment may be fitted, a Limited Slip Differential may also be fitted if not fitted as standard) Cars for which a Production car specification does not exist may compete if the entrant can obtain written consent from all other competitors in the category otherwise the entry will be allocated to the most appropriate category. Over 2 litres.

2.4 Class D As above for cars under 2 litres.

2.5 Class E All other cars complying with RAC regulations as per relevant section QA, QM & QG, otherwise free.

3. Safety Requirements. Cars must comply to the relevant section QM in the RAC Blue Book for the class involved.

4. General Technical Regulations and exceptions. Cars must comply with the relevant section Q in the RAC Blue Book for the class involved.

5 Chassis.

5.1 Modifications permitted. As per the Technical Regulations for Modified Saloon Cars, Group A, Production Saloons, or Section QA for the Class involved.
