

The return of high speed sports racing car action tops a mammoth 10 race programme at Pembrey today for the British Automobile Racing Club Championship Raceday.

Round 5 of the BARC Supersports Vauxhall Championship brings the 140mph sports racing cars back to Wales for the second time in a month. On Good Friday Tony Bridge won the race but only after fending off stern pressure from Bob Mears and Guy Woodward in a thrilling race. They are all returning for a re-match along with championship leader Peter Cocks. Having won the title in both 1989 and 1990 Bridge is facing very tough opposition from former F3 racer Mears (Phantom P91), Woodward (in the works Mallock Mk30) and Cocks. Likely to be up amongst the lead battle are two more drivers who both started from the back of the grid on Good Friday. Mike Evans and Mike **Swinnerton** should both be starting from near the front of the grid this time and so as many as six cars will be battling around the demanding Pembrey circuit. Charles Scammell and John Simpson head the next pack in what promises to be an action packed 16 lap race.

Supersport Vauxhall honours his brother **Clive** will be chasing another win in the BARC Sports 1600 race. **Malcolm Jackson**, making his Pembrey debut, will be Woodward's biggest threat.

Two packed grids for the M&G International MGOC races should generate plenty of close racing with the traditional Abingdon built sportscars out first. The MGB of **Grahame Davis** is unbeaten so far but **Terry Farman** and **Andrew Storer** in particular will be out


to stop that run of success. A capacity grid of saloon MG's includes Cardiff's **Richard Bennett** up against current class leaders **Michael Weidner** and **Robert Oldershaw**. The first lap charges into Hatchets Hairpin should not be missed!

Rounds of the URS Pre '83 FF2000 and QED Classic F3 Championships provide the single seater action with 1970s F3 star **Barrie Maskell** heading the entry for the former. **Nick Owen** is the man to beat in the FF2000 counter.

In complete contrast is a round of the Firestone National 2CV Championship. The French cult cars make another visit to Pembrey having provided great entertainment in previous races. Spectators can expect lots of side by side motoring from the multi-coloured 2CVs!

Local interest will centre on a round of the Welsh Racing Drivers Association Sports Saloons Championship. Colin Williams and Colin Gunderson head the entry in their Porsches but face the quick Capri of Blake Edwards and Andrew Wilson's 3 litre Escort.

Completing the programme are rounds of the new Westfield SE Sportscar and the MGCC Chapman Warren Classic Road Sports Championship.

Stuart stars at Pembrey

The Welsh Racing Drivers Assocation 1992 season started on Sunday at Pembrey with an exciting first round in the Welsh Sports and Saloon Car championship. Andrew Wilson from Dinas Powis dominated the race taking an easy win, but there was plenty of action behind as Cardiff's Colin Gunderson took his Porsche 911 to 2nd place after a struggle to pass Colin Williams who feel away to finish 6th after a teriffic tussle with Blake Edwards (4th) and Gary Evans (5th). The drive of the day came however came from Caerphilys' Mal Stuart, making his debut in the Welsh series, who powered his Avenger into 3rd place overall with a super display of car control. Wenvoes' Richard Bennett finished 7th after a racelong duel with Swanseas Ken Davies who headed a Swansea trio of himself, Chris Jones and Mike Hopkins to 8th, 9th and 10th repsectively.
