without tasting victory. Other potential front runners include **Rowland Bratt** and **Anthony Pownall** but perhaps the most significant entry is that of **Mark Fish**. A pacesetter for the last couple of seasons in both Renault 5GT Turbos and Clios, Fish has not raced regularly this season. Instead, he has concentrated on preparing cars for his brother **Simon** and **Bill Marks** but his return to racing today could prove to be the upset of the race!

All-Action Supports

Away from the two feature Renault races there promises to be plenty of good racing among the packed supporting programme. Continuing the Renault theme is a round of the Harlow Group Renault 5 Turbo Championship. These cars were the forerunners of the Clios and are still producing close, exciting racing. The entry is headed by brothers Craig and Nigel Albon. You may expect the brothers to race to team orders but that is far from the truth. They are fierce rivals on the track and race as hard against each other as they do against the rest of the field. No one else has yet won a race this season but Adam Simmons is the man most likely to break the Albon stranglehold!

Making its second visit of the year to Pembrey is the Pirelli Production Porsche Championship, which races in four classes based on the power and weight of the model concerned . . . it is a well established formula since the Championship has now been running for eight years.

Current Championship leader is **Hugh Price**, driving his Porsche 911SC, in Class C. Not far behind him in the overall points is Class A runner **Chris Heeley** in his Carrera RS. Third overall and first in Class D is **John Bussell**. Hugh Price currently looks like having a reasonably safe lead of 13.5 points; however, if anything goes wrong, Chris is right behind him.

In Class A the last few rounds have seen **Malcolm Sargent** putting pressure on Chris Heeley. **Jon Fletcher**, also in Class A, has had a tough season suffering a couple of

accidents, but he is back on the pace and well able to keep up with "young bloods" at the front of the Class.

Despite Price's substantial lead in Class C it remains a very competitive class, and though he may be well ahead of **Pete Chambers** on points, they are always in very close proximity on the track! Another Class C front-runner is **Robert Babikan** . . . he cannot win the class but he is determined to beat Price and Chambers before the season is over.

Class D is just as closely fought: again John Bussell has a comfortable lead on the points table but things are much closer on the track, with both **John Collings** and **Andrew Davies** equally capable of giving John Bussell a hard time!

At the other end of the 'one-make' racing scale is a round of the Firestone National 2CV Championship which has traditionally produced a thrilling race on previous visits to Pembrey. The action may be relatively slow but the racing is as close as in any category. Paul Saunders, Royce Grey, Bill Boldison and Richard Dalton head the entry.

In stark contrast to the bussing 2CVs are the highly modified specials contesting a round of the BARC/BRSCC, Silhouette Specials Championship. This one should be between **Robin Hooker's** Cosworth-powered Ferrari 308 clone and **Matthew Mortlock**'s turbocharged Escort. Worth a trip to the paddock alone are machines such as **Julian Mendus'** V8 Rover-powered Triumph Herald, **James Funnell's** very modified Morris Minor and **Bill Richards'** Cosworth engined Metro!

More single seater action is provided by rounds of the URS Pre '83 Formula Ford 2000 and Midtherm Flue Systems 74/80 Formula Ford 1600 Championships. In the 2 litre category **Steve Nichols**, **Nick Owen** and **Dave Nichols** should resume their seasonlong battle, while **Dave Hart** and **Chris Pickering** are tussling for the title in the FF1600 class.

Completing the racing are rounds of the Welsh Racing Drivers' Association Sports Saloon and BARC/500 Owners Association Formula 500 Championships.

In the former, Rhoose racer Colin Gunderson, driving his Porsche 911, enters the last round of the 1992 WRDA Welsh Sports and Saloon Car Championship at Pembrey today, having already scored 4 class wins and enough points to take the 1992 title from reigning champion Blake Edwards of Pontypridd. Gunderson has promised to finish his season in style having already come close to an outright win this season. However, Class A and Class C honours remain in doubt with Haverfordwest rally star Martin Davies pitting his Ford Escort against the resurgent Porsche Turbo of Dinas driver Colin Williams, who took his awesomely large car to victory in the last round. Class C for the smaller cars is also a contest to be decided on the day with the nippy Davrian of Trowbridge's Mike Lamplough needing to score well to fend of the challenge of Barry solicitor Gary Evans and his Mini.
