
# RACECHAT Paul Lawrence

This weekend marks the **Welsh Festival of Motorsport** at the Welsh Motor Sport Centre at **Pembrey** when the British Automobile Racing Club organises no fewer than 16 races over the two days with events for single seaters, sports cars, saloon cars and sidecars!

The Welsh Open Championship for Sidecars has three races each day for the intrepid riders and passengers. These machines are, effectively, three wheeled racing cars employing high-tech features and big slick racing tyres. Not only do they race hard and fast but the brave passengers perform all sorts of acrobatics to keep their weight distributed in the right place at the right time! After three races during Saturday afternoon qualifying, they return for another three races spread through Sunday's programme.

Headlining the four wheeled action is an hour long two-driver race for the BARC Production Car Cham**pionship**. This series is now very much the domain of the Ford Escort Cosworths and winners of the previous one-hour race at Pembrey were brothers Andy and Gary Britnell. Andy has since gone on to build a solid title lead but has come under increasing pressure in recent races as more Escort Cosworths have joined the fray. Most notable is the car of **Mike Thompson**, debuted at Donington recently, and if Thompson makes the journey to Pembrey the Britnell domination could be broken. Steve Papworth, too, is getting his Escort right into contention. With compulsory pit-stops for driver changes, this is one race where the pit crews could decide the eventual outcome.

Always popular at Pembrey is the Falken Tyres Modified Production Saloon Car Championship which has two races for these spectacular racing saloons. Andrew Mackenzie travels up from Brighton to try and win the Class A race in his 4 litre Opel Monza but will have to beat off the hard-charging Peter

**Barnes** in his superb Holden Commodore. Reigning champion **Craig Davies** is the man to beat in the second race in his Sapphire Cosworth.

More saloon car racing comes in a pair of races – rounds 8 and 9 – of the **Harlow Group Renault 5 Turbo Championship**. With the championship battle finely balanced between **Chris Grahame, Steve Alderton** and **Kevin Templeman**, the double-header comes at a critical point in the season. If any of them have a bad day at Pembrey, their title hopes could be dashed. If a driver hits trouble in the first race, expect some feverish paddock activity to get his car ready for the second race later in the afternoon.

Opening the racing early on Sunday morning is another round of the popular **P+P Supplies Welsh Sports and Saloon Car Championship** where the Welsh built Darrians again take on the Ford Cosworth powered cars of **Alvin Powell** (Sierra) and **Keith Butcher** (Escort). Towards the end of Sunday, the **BARC Wales/WRDA Formula Ford 1600 Championship** caters for local drivers – and Cornish visitors **Richard** and **Stephen Carter** – in the single seater racing cars.

A series less frequently seen at Pembrey is the **Kumho Tyres/X1-R** 

**BMW Car Club Championship** where a wide range of standard and modified BMWs race. Top dog is **Peter Challis** in his potent M5 but he has recently been beaten by series returnee **Geoff Cook** in his E21 model. **John Willcocks** – who is also running in the P+P Sports Saloon race – will be another front runner while the very new Compact, the only version of this car currently racing, of **Nigel Moseley** adds more variety.

Sports car racing is ably provided by a round of the RDS Automotive Sports 1600 Championship in which Barry Webb is moving closer to securing the championship title. He faces opposition from his team mate Peter Richings who won at Pembrey in May and Malcolm Jackson who is a constant threat to Webb wherever he races. Ian Mitchell and Mark Pierce will also race strongly as they head the challenge to the all-conquering Mallocks. Finally, a round of the Universal Racing Services Pre '83 Ford 2000 Championship will produce the fastest race of the day. Former champion Jeff Gresswell tops the entry but fellow Van Diemen RF82 racers Nick Pearce and Amnon Needham are his major rivals.

#### WELSH RACING DRIVERS ASSOCIATION SPORTS SALOON CHAMPIONSHIP


The Welsh Racing Drivers Association Sports Saloon Championship, based at Pembrey circuit, continues for its fifth season in 1995, and this year enjoys the support of P+P Supplies Limited, of Cardiff.

Points will be awarded to registered competitors listed as classified finishers in the Final Results as follows:- 4 or more eligible starters in the class: 1st - 4; 2nd - 3; 3rd - 2; 4th - 1. 3 eligible starters in the class: 1st - 3; 2nd - 2; 3rd - 1. 2 eligible starters in the class: 1st - 2; 2nd - 1. 1 eligible starter in the class: 1st - 1, plus one extra point for the competitor(s) achieving or equalling the race fastest lap in the class. In the case of only one starter to the class the point will be awarded if the race fastest lap equals or betters the class lap record.

Championship positions will be determined by the points totals of competitors, the maximum number of rounds to count being the total number of qualifying rounds less 2, in the event of seven or less rounds being run all scores will count.
