The 2CVs need little introduction to Pembrey spectators as the French cult-cars have raced here regularly. Their races are always close and always fun and it is **Gary Byatt** who is starting to stamp his authority on the championship. However, back at the start of August at Pembrey father and son team **Tim** and **Royce Grey** kept Byatt away from victory. The championship concludes at Mallory Park next Sunday.


The Pre '85 FF1600 race is traditionally a battle-grown for the classic designs of the early 1980's. The Van Diemen RF84 and the Lola T644 are the cars to have, just as they were 10 years ago when handled by youngsters like Damon Hill and Bertrand Gachot!

John Simpson is the man to beat in the Fiat races with his Uno and is out to go one better than his runner-up position last year. Heading the chase are **Roger Suckling** and 1992 champion **Brian Cowe** in their Unos but Simpson will be hard to catch.

This meeting also witnesses the final round of the BARC Wales/WRDA Formula Ford 1600 Championship. This has been the first year of this new series which is set to steadily grow in popularity. The title will be resolved in a single race on Saturday afternoon when Cornishman Richard Carter and Salisbury's Robin Parsons will battle for the title.

The other Welsh championship – the P+P Supplies/BARC Wales/WRDA Sports Saloon series – has its penultimate round on Saturday afternoon. This championship will not finish until the Truck meeting here at the end of October but the spoils seem likely to go to Haverfordwest in the hands of **Martin Davies** and his very rapid Sapphire Cosworth.

Among his rivals are Bristolian **Keith Butcher** (Escort Cosworth), **Peter Dark** (Pontrhydfendigaid) in his Darrian T90 and the redoubtable **Glynne Jones** from Lampeter in his aged but effective Ford Anglia.

BARC WALES/WRDA FORMULA FORD 1600 CHAMPIONSHIP

The Welsh Formula Ford Championship is organised and administered by BARC Wales and WRDA, and will be contested over five rounds at Pembrey Circuit during 1995.

Classes (new from August 6th onwards): 1 – Any Formula Ford Cars (Kent engine only) built from 1990 onwards; 2 – 1986–1989; 3 – 1981–1985; 4 – Pre 1981.

Points in each class at each round (subject to number of starters): 4–3–2–1 plus 1 for fastest lap. In the case of only one starter in the class, the point will be awarded if the race fastest lap equals or betters the class lap record.
