Welsh contest in saloon spectacle

CLASSIC saloon car racing features strongly at Pembrey Circuit on Sunday when the British Automobile Racing Club organise a championship raceday.

It includes another round of the P and P Supplies Welsh Sports and Saloon Car Championship which has produced the best racing at the circuit this season.

Double champion Martin Davies from Haverfordwest in his Sapphire Cosworth will be seeking further points to boost his chances of making a hat-trick of titles.

But several other potential champions have emerged this season in a series in which the standard of racing and crowd pleasing action has earned considerable praise from regulars to the circuit.

Winner of the last round during the Jaguar Car Club meeting was Carmarthen's Terry Brown in a Kawasaki powered Darrian T90 and will be looking to repeat that performance.

But equally determined to notch up a victory is Llanelli based saloon car racer Mike Schmidt who has been involved in several dramatic incidents in previous rounds. He has being keeping the body shop busy this summer after his spectacular driving has seen his car come to grief on a couple of occasions.

But there is little doubt that he has the power to challenge for the championship, having already smashed the lap record for the series earlier this summer.

Darrian The Pontrhydfendigaid's Peter Dark is also consistently among the leaders and will be making a determined bid to take the chequered flag this weekend to improve his standards.

Main feature of the BARC weekend is four championships for saloon cars spanning more than 20 years of British racing history.

First on the grid will be the Post Historic Touring Car Championship with the favourite to win the round being Milton Keynes Nigel Garrett in a

Triumph Dolomite Sprint. Flying the Welsh flag will be Builth

Wells driver Mark Osborne, also in a Triumph Dolomite Sprint.

Moving back an era there will be a combined race for the Classic and

Historic Touring Car Championships.

Quickest of the wide variety of cars in this race should be the Jaguar Mk2 of former motorbike racer Alec Hammond and the Ford Mustang of Tony Alec Scott-Andrews.

Chasing the Jaguar and Mustang will be the Lotus Cortinas of Philip Dicker and Thomas Lailey de Ville.

The Classic division caters for Pre-1960 cars and could see another giantkilling performance from the remarkable Austin A35 of Peter St Barbe.

Completing the period saloon car action is a round of the Group One Touring Car Championship when Garrett is back out with his hard-worked Dolomite Sprint in search of a championship double.

The thundering 4.5 litre Rover SDI of Gerry Cain is the car to beat in the BARC/RSCC Modified Production Saloon Car Championship.

His main threat is expected to come from Simon Light in a 3.1 lite Ford Capri.

The best 2 lite cars will be close at hand and 1994 champion Craig Davies in a Ford Sapphire and John Hammersley, Astra GTE, will chase the bigger cars around Pembrey.

But it is the 1600 cc Ford Fiesta XR2 of defending champion Michael helm that is starting to make a break at the top of the points table.

Fastest race of the day will be round eight of the Universal Racing Services Classic Ford 2000 Championship.

The class has enjoyed great battles this year among the pack of Van Diemen RF82s which is headed by Nicholas Pearce. Brothers David and Simon Hutchinson are chasing hard and the leader of class B for Pre 1981 cars Colin Wright will be bidding for a podium finish as well as another class win.

Qualifying from 9.30 a.m while the racing starts at 2p.m.
