




and Historic Touring Car Championship but faces the very successful Jaguar MkII of Alec Hammond. Les has been racing for more than 30 years, but is still as competitive as ever even though he no longer races regularly. Rivalling his Lotus Cortina are similar cars in the hands of Thomas Lailey de Ville, Ron Cosgrove and Peter Taylor. Bristol's Reg Salway – in his first season of racing – tops the classes for Pre '60 Classic Saloons in his Morris Minor.

Local racers have two rounds of the P+P Supplies Welsh Sports & Saloon Car Championship with Carmarthen's Terry Brown (Darrian T9) hoping to extend his winning form. Also racing examples of the Lampeter-built sports car are Peter Dark and Gareth Davies while the unusual Forzari GTi of Paul Welch is scheduled to appear. Former rally driver Martin Davies heads the Cosworth-powered contenders in his M&S Engineering Cosworth. With two races during Sunday, this is an important weekend for the title contenders.

More diverse and highly-modified cars contest the seventh round of the ACE Vehicle Deliveries Sports and Saloon Car Championship with an entry headed by the Nissan 100-based special of Richard Harris and Dorsetman Steve Hall in his Ford Fiesta, who makes his debut at Pembrey. Andy Clarkin brings his Cavalier out for a warm-up prior to the Formula Saloon race but it is class E racer Garry Wilson who heads the championship after a run of five straight class wins in his rare Lenham Le Mans Coupe. This is Garry's 17th season of racing in this car and he is bidding to clinch the championship title that he just missed out on last year.

The BARC/RSCC Modified Production Saloon Car Championship pays its only visit of the year to Wales with Ray West (Opel Manta) bidding to maintain his unbeaten record. The Hampshireman should again be the class of the field but needs to keep winning if he is to secure the crown as Scott Austin (Escort RS2000) and Mark Chandler (Rover Mini) are chasing hard from their respective classes. Running concurrently with the Modified Production Saloons are the BARC Renault Clio Cup contenders, where Darren Clarke leads David Willoughby by three class wins to two in the opening five races.

Finally, an hour-long two-driver round of the Andyspares/Firestone National 2CV Championship brings out a capacity field as the teams limber up for the 24-hour race at Mondello Park in Ireland next month! This is only the third round of the 1997 championship but **Royce Grey** has already bagged a brace of victories and he is partnered in this race by his son **Tim.** 1966 champion **Gary Byatt** is teamed with the man he narrowly pipped to the title, **Nathan Barker**, to make a

HEN the Llandow circuit near Cowbridge closed its doors to circuit racing, Wales was left without a race track until the efforts to open up the Pembrey circuit reached fruition at the end of the 1980s. Today, Pembrey is an important part of British motorsport and is one of the most widely-used venues in the country.

This weekend heralds a two-day meeting organised by the British Automobile Racing Club, owners of the circuit lease. The BARC has done much to develop Pembrey as a venue and their commitment and investment has been rewarded by a venue that is in use virtually every weekend of the season, and frequently during the week.

But it is not just car racing that keeps the circuit busy. Pembrey is host to just about every form of motorsport with motorbikes, scooters, karts and trucks all racing here. Add in car sprints, rallycross and special stage rallying and you have a venue that benefits all branches of the sport.

Away from race weekends, Pembrey is regularly host to teams testing and developing their cars. The manufacturers in the British Touring Car Championship are frequent visitors, recognising the challenging track as an ideal testing venue with its mix of fast and slow corners.

Pembrey is a fine venue that offers much to its users, whatever type of wheeled-sport they follow. With an on-going programme of investment and improvement – which included complete re-surfacing of the track in recent months - the Welsh Motor Sport Centre is a vital part of British motorsport.
