

## Mondello Park International Racing Circuit

MONDELLO PARK GEARS UP TOWARDS THE MILLENNIUM!

#### **IRELAND**

Ireland's premier motor racing circuit, Mondello Park gears up towards Millennium with a bumper package of motorsport entertainment in 1999, spearheaded by the Formula 1 BOSS cars, a round of the FIA Thoroughbred Grand Prix cars and the inaugural visit by the Formula Palmer Audi class.

On the 2.25-mile International circuit, the prestigious RAC Superprix will bring the drama and heady sound of Formula 1 cars to the Kildare track for a round of the Formula BOSS (Big Open Single-Seater) Championship on May 15/16. For the third year running, mid-90s Grand Prix machinery, including a gaggle of Tyrrells, Jordans, Arrows and a Benetton B194, will be in action with the intrepid drivers aiming for a new outright circuit lap record.

Two rounds of former Grand Prix driver, Dr Jonathan Palmer's hugely-successful Formula Palmer Audi Championship will be included in the same meeting. The series gives aspiring young drivers the chance to race on the demanding Mondello Park International circuit. Two rounds of the fabulous Radical Sports Car Championship is also scheduled for the bumper two-day meeting.

There's a real festival planned for July 17/18 - Historic Sport Car Festival & Classic Car Show when several UK categories will compete in the Intermediate circuit, spearheaded by the International Supersports Cup for historic two-seater and sports racing cars, comprising some of the biggest English names in historic racing. The nostalgic theme continues with championship rounds for the International Supersport Cup, RJB Mining Sports Cars, the Chris Alford Formula Ford 1600 series, Historic Saloons and GTs, a Road-Going Sports Car race and a round of the Supersprint series, all of which is designed to really get the adrenalin going.

Top class motorsport in Ireland also features the **FIA-sanctioned Thoroughbred Grand Prix cars** on **August 7/8**. Pristine racing machinery dating back to 1970 with a Lotus 72 and a Brabham BT33 will be two of the more elderly Grand Prix cars at the circuit, while from the 70s, there's an abundance of Marches, Surtees, Williams, Heskeths, Tyrrells and Brabhams to name but a few. From the 80s, there will be many of the ground-effect carfrom the era with a strong representation from Ferrari, Lotus, Arrows and Williams.

All of Ireland's domestic championships provide the backbone of national racing throughout the year with strong grids on the cards for all classes, including Formula Opel, Formula Ford Zetec and the all-new Dunlop RT2000 super touring car class. There'll be the usual action from the Yokohama Fiat Uno brigade and the Yokohama Italian Saloon Car Championship featuring plucky fast lady, Michelle Graham, in the Motofit entry.

An abundance of Formula Vee cars will battle out the three Dunlop-sponsored classes, the tyre giant also supporting the Dunlop Historics and Dunlop Stryker Sportscar Challenge, while the resurgent Formula Ford 1600 single-seaters promise more close wheel-to-wheel action in the ACEC All-Ireland Star of Tomorrow series.

The annual **Leinster Trophy Motor Races**, will once again feature rounds of the EFDA Euroseries for Formula Opel single-seaters along side all National Championships on **18/19th September**. Further details to be announced later in the season.

Racing Truck Show 99 on 14/15th August Monster Action at Mondello...... No other outdoor Show can BEAT IT! The Racing Truck Show and Truckfest Ireland '98 was the top of the bill last August for the fifth year running. Over the two days an array of amazing action from the British Racing Trucks performing with speed and power; The World champion motorcycle stuntmaster, Gary Rothwell performing impossible stunts, The Amazing French Rolling Truck. Alongside all the track entertainment and noise the Truckfest give the professional Haulier a chance to scoop national
