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RACECHAT by Paul Lawrence

A host of national motor racing, headed by two races for the Europa Cup, features at Pembrey this weekend as the Automobile Racing British organises the Anglo/Irish Challenge at the Welsh Motorsport Centre.

No less than 15 races will be held during the weekend, with six on Sunday and the remaining nine on Bank Holiday Monday. The Europa Cup, a category for 2-litre Vauxhall powered single-seater racing cars, has a 20-lap race each day and will include a round of the Irish Formula Opel Championship for similar cars. These evenly-matched cars are the type of machinery in which current World Champion Mika Hakkinen and McLaren team-mate David Coulthard first made their names.

Now, another crop of youngsters are bidding to show their talents in the 140mph racing cars. In the opening race of the season, highly-rated Japanese racer Takuma Sato won in brilliant style in the rain at Donington. His win that day came at the expense of Tomas Scheckter, younger son of 1979 World Champion Jody. Sato is being run by the highly-experienced Diamond Racing team which has a strong South Wales

flavour. Port Talbot-based brothers Claude and Emyr Price are engineers for the team and are buzzing about the raw talent being shown by Sato. He is expected to make his Formula 3 debut this summer and is already being described as one of the best young Japanese drivers ever to come to Europe.

Particularly strong is the three-car line up from the Meritus team which includes Americans Paul Edwards and Ryan Walker along with Brazilian Fabricio Masullo. Edwards is probably the strongest of the trio at this stage and recently led the opening round of the EFDA Euroseries for these cars at the Zolder track in Belgium.

Young British racer Darren Malkin is also expected this weekend in the Fortec Motorsport entry along with Sherwood Justin and Lance Robson. Adding further spice to the contest is the presence of a group of Irish-based racers who will be chasing points in their own championship as well as going for outright success. Michael Keohane raced to fourth at Donington but the most recent round of the Irish Championship was won by David Collier from Vivion Daly.

The Irish flavour to the meeting is developed by three other races on Sunday as rounds of the Ford of Ireland Zetec Formula Ford, Irish RT2000 and Dunlop Stryker Sportscar Championships travel across the water to Pembrey. The Formula Ford racers are headed by gourmet chef George McAlpin, in his French-built Mygale SJ99, Paul Dagg, Alan Ring and Raymond Knox in what will be the

third round of their championship.

The RT2000 series is an exciting new category for purpose-built racing saloons with tubular spaceframe chassis and 2-litre engines. The cars are built by Sonny Howard, the man behind the Eurocar concept, and this will be the first race outside Ireland for the cars which are being promoted as a cost-effective one-make category in Ireland. Around 10 cars are expected for the early season races, with more due to join in as the new class rapidly gains popularity.

Meanwhile, the sportscars make their Pembrey debut and will be headed by Jonathan Fildes who won a thrilling opening round at Mondello Park at Easter. Fildes, who works a precision driver in the film industry, has recently spent time in Italy working on a new film and will be aiming to extend his championship advantage in this third race of the season. His main rivals include Jonathan Taylor, who ran a very close second at Easter, Robert Bradley and Paul Murphy.

Completing Sunday's racing are races for the BARC Wales/WRDA Sports and Saloon Championship and the rapid single-seater Monoposto Championship.

The local Sports and Saloon series has produced some good racing and gives South Wales racers the chance to contest a championship without the cost and time burden of travelling throughout the UK to other tracks.

The nimble Darrians dominate the pack and the latest T90 design from Lampeter farmer **Tim Duffee** is set to win again. **Peter Dark** and **Graham Cole** are ranged against the motorbike-engined version of **Terry Brown** while former multiple champion **Martin Davies** will be chasing hard in his Sapphire Cosworth. The classes for less modified cars are worth a closer look with some unusual but very effective racing machinery like the Toyota MR2 of **Colin Williams**.

As one of Britain's longest-established single-seater classes, the Monoposto Championship is booming in 1999 and an over-flowing grids of cars will round off Sunday's programme. Although originally aimed at self-built cars, the class has moved progressively towards commercially built racing cars at least two or three years old. Ironically, as many as seven examples of Formula Vauxhall cars will be in the field. The current name for Formula Vauxhall is, of course, Europa Cup!

The race will be a straight fight between the former F3 Ralt RT3s and the Formula Vauxhalls and, as is always the case in Monoposto races, the entry dominated by drivers Gloucestershire. The classic Ralt designs are raced by Monoposto veterans Francis Phillips, David Cox and Jim Blockley while the leading Formula Vauxhalls are handled by Robin Dawe, Jason Timms, Jensen Lunn and Cardiff's **Geoff Tremblett**. Stepping up to class A this year with another Formula Vauxhall is Keith Linforth and former Westfield racer Richard Davies has also taken this route. The one car capable of upsetting the Ralt and Formula Vauxhall contest is the rare Anson SA4 of David Dudley. This Formula 3 car was the work of Gary Anderson before he went on to design Grand Prix cars for the Jordan team.

Class B of the Monoposto series is for less powerful cars and those using motorbike engines. Although **Paul Shipp** often sets the pace, Chippenham teenager **Adam Smith** is one to watch.

As the son of former BTCC racer Nigel and the younger brother of Formula Palmer Audi racer Martyn, Adam will not lack sound advice and drove superbly to claim the class at Castle Combe on Easter Monday. The third Monoposto class is for cars using the faithful Kent Formula Ford engine and it is the vastly-experienced **Simon Davey** who heads the field.

Monday's busy race programme opens with the second Europa Cup race and also features a host of prestigious national categories. Two races for the Bell Security Guarding Formula Saloon Championship bring out some of the fastest and most developed racing

race cars similar to those used in the British Touring Car Championship. Notable entriesinclude the Vauxhall Cavaliers of regular Pembrey racer **Keith Butcher** and **Simon Dickinson**.

Enjoying tremendous support this season is the BoilingPOINT ARP Formula 3 Championship for the F3 single-seaters of the late 80s and early 90s. A gaggle of potential winners for a pair of races include reigning champion **Daron Bland** and '98 Pembrey winner **Neil Cox**. Bland was desperately unlucky to lose the opening round at Mallory Park back in March when a lastlap tangle with a backmarker forced him

saloons in the country. The mighty Cosworth-powered Fords of **Gareth Lloyd** and **Garry Woodcock** head the entry. Reigning champion **Ric Wood** is switching to an ex-Australian Touring Car Championship Holden Commodore for this season and, if the car is ready in time, he could race it this weekend. Woodcock, meanwhile, is now one of the driving forces behind the category and will be hoping to repeat the victory he scored here last August.

Back racing after a break from competition is **Andrew McKenzie** in his rare Opel Omega and another Opel, this time the Monza of **Andre Bentley**, is entered in the class for less-modified cars. The other class is for 2-litre former Super Touring cars and is attracting growing interest from drivers wanting to

out. Although Daron and his father run the car on a shoestring, his Reynard 863 is still one of the quickest cars in the pack even though many newer cars are racing.

Winner that day at Mallory instead was Scott Stringfellow, son of night club supremo Peter, who was making a return to racing after a break. Scott is racing the Ralt RT34 of Martin Sismey this season but had to give best in the second round at Brands to Jeff Gresswell's Dallara F388. Other notable runners in a cracking field category include veteran Dave Karaskas, former Historic Formula Ford ace Benn Simms, one time Supersports racer Chris Marshall and **Enzo Mucci**, the fastest pizza delivery driver in Redditch! Jim Blockley, meanwhile, switches from his Monoposto Ralt to a rare Bowman BC3 for Monday's races.

Another Bowman could be ready in time for this meeting as former ARP F3 champion John Loebell has been developing one of the chassis. He has been concentrating on sorting the handling of the car in recent test sessions but if all has gone well, he may be back on the grid this weekend.

More saloon car action will be provided by round four of the ABP Motorsport/ Yokohama Tyres Modified Production Saloon Championship for cars rather less developed than the Formula Saloons. Rover racer Gerry Cain should set the overall pace but the smaller cars of Douglas Anderson, Richard Shepherd and David Pearson will run him close at Pembrey.

However, at a damp Oulton Park in round three two weeks ago it was Scot Tony Caig who saw off his countryman Anderson to score his first win of the season. Shepherd and Pearson, after enjoying a mighty battle at Thruxton, ended their race in the same gravel trap at Oulton. Shepherd slid off on the first lap while Pearson joined him in the Lodge gravel on the last lap! Thanks to the enthusiastic support of ABP Motorsport, the Cheshire based performance spares specialist, the class is heading back towards good health this year. John Parton, boss of ABP, will again be racing his Citroen AX GT in class D of the championship.

Concluding this terrific weekend of racing will be rounds of the Firestone MGOC Race Championship and Caterham Graduate Championship. The MGOC pack is split, as usual, into the rear-wheel drive sportscars and front-wheel drive saloons and a great entry of Maestros and Montegos will contest the final race of the weekend. Reigning champion **Robb Addison** tops the entry and won the most recent round at Snetterton. But he faces a tough challenge from **Adrian Groocock** and **Andy Campbell**.

After a season contesting the highprofile MGF Cup, **Terry Farman** has returned to the calmer waters of the MGOC series for sportscar MGs. With two wins from the first two races he has made the perfect start to the year but will have plenty to think about as **Sean**



Wilkin and **David Williams** shared the spoils in the opening two races, but a double-header at the Anglesey circuit last weekend could have put some new names to the head of the points table.



Points will be awarded to registered competitors listed as classified finishers in the Final Results as follows: -4 or more eligible starters in the class: 1st -4; 2nd -3; 3rd -2; 4th -1. 3 eligible starters in the class: 1st -3; 2nd -2; 3rd -1. 2 eligible starters in the class: 1st -2; 2nd -1. 1 eligible starter in the class: 1st -1, plus one extra point for the competitor(s) achieving or equalling the race fastest lap in the class. In the case of only one starter to the class the point will be awarded if the race fastest lap equals or betters the class lap record. One extra point for all competitors participating in practice or race at any events other than at Pembrey.
