

## Wales plan to bring back motor racing

A PUBLIC meeting to discuss the prospects for motor racing in Wales in 1984 will be held at the Cothi Bridge Hotel, near Carmarthen, on Wednesday (9pm) by the Welsh Racing Drivers Association.
