

The Principles of the WRDA MSA are to provide close and exciting racing with modern competitive cars in sufficient numbers to promote spectator interest. It will foster its own championships for the benefit of its members and the general public. It will provide races of differing lengths and status. In the interest of close and exciting racing it may be necessary to handicap certain championships. However the principle will always allow the better driver to win.

Racing Championships.

- 1) The W.R.D.A. Welsh All Comers Championship for Formula Ford 1600cc cars (as set out in R.A.C. Technical Regulations) for the title - Welsh Formula Ford Champion.
- 2) The W.R.D.A. Welsh Special G.T. Championship for Modified Sports Cars and Special Saloon Cars (as set out in R.A.C. Technical Regulations) for the title - Welsh Grand Master.
- 3) The W.R.D.A. Welsh Open Championship for all comers in open wheel, flat bottom, single seater cars (complying with R.A.C. Technical Regulations covering race vehicles, i.e. section QG) for the title - Welsh Open Champion, in addition there will be a Class A for 2 litre cars and a Class B for 1 litre cars.
- 4) The W.R.D.A. Top Drivers Championship for road going cars (to comply with the R.A.C. Technical Regulations covering closed cars), for the title - W.R.D.A. Top Driver. Cars should be taxed, have a current M.O.T. and be driven to the circuit.
- 5) The W.R.D.A. Sprint Championship.
- 6) The W.R.D.A. Formula 3 Championship (for cars complying with F.I.A. Formula 3 Technical Regulations).
- 7) The W.R.D.A. Formula 2 championships (for cars complying with the F.I.A. Formula 2 Technical Regulations).
- 8) The W.R.D.A. Group C Championship (for cars complying with F.I.A. Group C regulations.)
- 9) The W.R.D.A. Group A Championship (for cars complying with R.A.C. F.I.A. Group A Technical Regulations)

All Races. Minimum number of entries 10. If minimum number not reached then the organisers reserve the right to cancel the races or amalgamate it with another race.

N.B. During the first year all championships will be closed to all, except Club Members.
