

Cardiff's Julian roars on

CARDIFF'S Julian Westwood moved into second place in the British Formula 3000 motor-racing championship after finishing second in the eighth round at Donington Park yesterday as his main rivals failed to score.

Westwood recovered from an accident at the first corner which led to the race being restarted.

The Datamatic team replaced the nose and rear wing in time for the restart. The race was won by Swedish driver Anders Exblom, who finished 13 seconds ahead of Westwood.

Westwood's points put him second in the championship behind the tragic Paul Warwick, who died last month. Next in the 11-race series is at Brands Hatch on September 8.
