LAMPETER'S Tim Davies set the fastest lap as a fine second place in the Townsend Thoresen Euro motor race at Hockenheim yesterday morning and ended his run of disappointments in the European championship. Davies was second fastest in practice and led at the start, but rain had dampened the track and he would not respond to the challenge of Brazilian Maurc Gugelmin, an easy winner.

Davies then came under an attack from his Swallow team-mate, Andy Wallace, but he survived to take second place, and also the Driver of the Race trophy.
